The National Education & Learning Summit brings together education experts, educationalists, policy makers, and leaders of industry to discuss these themes to pave the way forward in an attempt to make Malaysian education truly world-class. It is a meeting of minds to discuss the critical issues and major challenges facing Malaysian education and the way forward.
